I am writing to encourage that you study Ethanone, 1-(1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8-octahydro-2,3,8,8-tetramethyl-2-naphthalenyl) in the National Toxicology Program (NTP) study.

First of all, Iso E Super is in wide use in fragrance products to which I, and more and more people, are experiencing severe adverse effects. Secondly, this compound is in common use in fragrances, often at levels of 25%.

Additionally, there is a lack of available health data on this chemical.
