## **ICCVAM Participation in OECD TG Program**

- April 24-27, 2018: First time that an ICCVAM representative attended the OECD WNT as an official US participant (supporting the national coordinator, Wanda Hall)
- 34 agenda items, ranging from updates to test guidelines and guidance documents, to progress reports on scientific activities, to new proposals
- The ICCVAM WNT representative position will be filled based on scientific need and contribution to the topics under discussion



# **OECD WNT Highlights**

- 2 New TGs + Validation Report Approved on Fish Hepatic Metabolism
- 6 Updated Test Guidelines Approved
- 3 New Guidance Documents (GDs) Approved
  - Good In Vitro Methods Practices (GIVIMP)
- 4 Updated GDs Approved
  - Evaluation of Chemicals for Endocrine Disruption
- 15 New Proposals Submitted: 13 Approved, 2 Withdrawn



# **OECD WNT Highlights**

- Simplifying TG adoption process
- Better guidance on optional endpoints
- Increase involvement in the identification and prioritization of needs for AOP development
- Workshop on ethical issues associated with the use of human derived products (e.g. serum) in in vitro assays
- Research project on toxicity behavior in fish (signs of moribundity)



## **International Harmonization**

- OECD proposal co-led by US, EU, and Canada
  - Included in OECD work plan April 2017
  - Create an international performance based test guideline for non-animal skin sensitization testing strategies
  - Achieve widespread replacement of mouse test
- Evaluation framework agreed upon at special OECD session in December, 2017
  - Formed expert group on skin sensitization DAs, including subgroups on uncertainty and applicability domain
  - Expert review of simple, rule-based DAs in progress (June 2018)

- Promote international cooperation in the areas of validation studies, independent peer review, and development of harmonized test methods.

- OECD Memorandum of Understanding with China
