Thank you for being available to accept comments on fluoride toxicity for the National Toxicology Program. I published two articles on the subject that are attached. The **Journal of Environmental and Public Health** describes the mechanisms of fluoride toxicity in humans, at high concentrations as during accidental overfeeds, as well as intermediate and chronic low level exposures.
