Stakeholders and federal agencies should work together to establish confidence in NAMs using flexible, integrated approaches to testing that span from early development to the ultimate intended use.

- Clearly delineate testing requirements and context of use.
- Promote the use of new approaches for establishing confidence.
- Utilize public-private partnerships to promote cross-sector communication and cooperation.
- Create centralized data access points that are publicly available and easily accessible.
- Actively solicit the submission and collation of parallel data from animal studies and alternative methods.
